Opening Questions

1. When you think about Jesus' ministry between His baptism and ascension, what stands out to you as being important to Him?
2. As you think about your own faith, what stands out to you as important things that you are passionate about accomplishing?

1. In Luke 5:13 Jesus says He is willing to make the man with leprosy well, and instantly heal him. Why do you think some people experience an instant supernatural-type of healing and others do not?
2. While we obviously cannot heal in the same way that Jesus does, in what ways can you share in the healing ministry with those around you?

On Love:

1. Can you think of a time when you were down and out, and someone showed you love in a way that made a difference? If so, can you share?
2. How do you know when someone is not able to make it on their own, and when they need help from someone else?

On Obedience:

1. What do you think are some things that a lot of Christians struggle with being obedient with?

2. What kinds of things can a Christian do to make sure they are being obedient to all the instruction given to us in Scripture?

On Commission:

1. Since Jesus is the highest authority in heaven and on earth, why do you think that obedience to His commands are not always automatic?
2. A writer once said, "if you truly believe that God loves you, you will not hesitate to obey Him." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not?
