Now we get to enjoy the change of seasons and the new opportunities and experience each brings (even if it’s shoveling snow or wiping our brows from the heat of summer!). The change is welcome.

Our Church's New Season

We are at a point in our journey as a church where we are entering a new season of ministry. This has come about as we officially will have three new staff all in place by August 4. We've added Matt Beck as Pastor of Worship, Angie Jacobson as our new Children's Ministry Director and Ryan Bear as our new Pastor of Discipleship (including oversight of our Young Adult's Ministry). They come with their families to be part of our ministry in “*reaching and equipping all ages for a lifetime of following Jesus*”. They come to equip us all as a church family (along with Pastor Mike, Pastor John and myself) to carry on God's great ministry here at Ustick. This is a wonderful new season in our church going forward!

What Can We Do in This Season?

We can do the following to help these dear servants in this new season for them and us:

- We can encourage them. They have embarked on this journey of ministry with us by faith. They each have left different states, transitioned out of a church family they loved and cared for and have left friends and family behind. That's tough! So whatever we can do to encourage them, let's do so!
- We can warmly welcome them. Let's go out of our way to introduce ourselves. Let's have them over for a meal. Let's offer help in moving or sharing where to get things in Boise and how to avoid driving on Eagle Road! Reach out to them as you would want to be welcomed to a new town and church.
- We can be willing to join their ministry team. Nothing can help a new staff person adjust to new ministry better than to know that there are people who are willing to come alongside to serve with them. Nothing can build relationships with them faster than to say, “How can I help you?”
- We can (and must!) pray for them! Again, each have left behind many loved ones and friends. Each have said, “I will go to follow Jesus”. Each have stepped out in faith and faithfulness to say that they are willing in this season to join with our church fellowship to build His kingdom. They will only thrive as they are held up in prayer (as is true for those already on staff and who serve in any way in our church family).

An Exciting Season to Anticipate!

When we first moved to Boise we would hear about a “slight chance of snow” and because that was new to us, we would stand on the front porch of our house with our kids and wait for it to snow! We soon learned that, well, “slight chance” really meant “no chance”! But we couldn't wait for that change of seasons. We anticipated it as only those from “sunny” and not “snowy” Southern California could. Anticipation should mark this season of our church life. We should be excited to see by faith what God continues to do and will do, not just with our new staff but with us as we all renew and rekindle our commitment to Jesus as His church. This is an “appointed time” by God and I for one can't wait to see the “events” He has for us as we faithfully follow Him in this new and great season of our church life!

"Blessed be the Lord who daily bears our burden, the God who is our salvation. God is to us a God of deliverances; and to God the Lord belong escapes from death." Psalm 68:19-20

King David wrote this Psalm as a “song of deliverance” from his enemies and we are blessed from the riches of scripture from those hard times he went through in his life. Verse 32 in this chapter says, “Sing to God, O kingdoms of the earth, sing praise to the Lord.” I encourage you to do just that, especially during the hard times you go through and if you get the opportunity listen to this song on YouTube, “Song Of My Father” by Urban Rescue. Thanks to everyone for your continued love, prayers, and support. I am doing great and praising God! Many of you have also had close calls with death (like Mike Veit recently...and praying for you brother!) and God has delivered you, so praise Him for that, often! But many of us have also experienced loved ones who have died and that is hard to say the least! That’s why I love how these verses start out...

"Blessed be the Lord who daily bears our burden, the God who is our salvation." He does bear our burdens and HE IS OUR SALVATION!

Here is one who had “an escape from death recently”, meet our granddaughter, Aliya Lauriel Anderson.

Here is what our daughter Nicole said after they brought Aliya home...

“Though she be but little, she is fierce.” Meet Aliya Lauriel (pron. “Uh-LEE-uh” “Larr-ee-EL”). Her first name origins are in Hebrew and Greek meaning, “called up and crowned with victory of God”. Her middle name is after Karen’s sister, Aunt Laurie, who went to be with the Lord almost 20 years ago. Aliya was born July 15 at 6lb, 15oz & 19 3/4 inches long. Aliya has a big story starting out her little journey with complications but she’s completely fine now and we’re all working on adjusting to adding a new member to our family...and trying to catch up on needed sleep!
